

**Lichen List** generated during the Friends of the Farlow Clara Cummings Walk held May 14, 2022, along Turkey Hill and small abutting sections of trails in the Whitney & Thayer Woods, Cohasset and Hingham, MA (map).

Field observations and limited collecting was done by members of The Friends of the Farlow during the walk to generate a lichen list for The Trustees of Reservations. Lichens were studied on the bark of oak, maple, hickory, and white pine trees along the trails and a few lignicolous stumps were also studied along and across the trails leading from the Turkey Hill Parking lot, on route 6a, to trail junction #30 and along to the Turkey Hill Lane trail leading to the summit parking lot on Turkey Hill. The large boulders outlining the parking lot, a small section of rock wall, and the cement of the abandoned NIKI Radar Station building, and remains of an old foundation were studied on the summit. The lichen checklist for the different substrates was compiled by Hal Schaefer, Michaela Schmuell, Judy Jacob, and Elizabeth Kneiper. James Mitchell added *Sarea resiniae*, a nonlichenized fungus on white pine resin, and *Phaeocalicium polyporaenum* on *Trichaptum bifforme* (Polypore Pins).
